The Problem



Sin has gotten so bad in this age that many don't even acknowledge God's existence and rationalize that this life is all there is. But deep down inside, all people know the truth because God has written key fundamentals of His Law on their hearts (Romans 2:14-15).

Another aspect of being in the image of God is that all people will exist into eternity future. But the issue is, where will you spend eternity? Those who pass God's test will spend eternity with Him, those who fail will spend it separated from Him in punishment: "for the wages of sin is death" (Romans 6:23). This death is spiritual death and also called the "second death" in Revelation 21:8.


