Philippians 2:5-11 – ⁵Your attitude should be the same as Why was it necessary for Christ to so humble himself? that of Christ Jesus: ⁶Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, ⁷but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. ⁸And being found in What is the principle here that disciples of Christ should appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became apply to their lives? obedient to death — even death on a cross! ⁹Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, What does Christ-like humility look like at work? ¹¹and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
